

Scam Awareness

Scammers often pose as trusted organizations like the IRS, delivery services, banks, or tech support to pressure you into acting quickly. Common tactics include urgent messages, fake prizes, account warnings, and requests to pay using gift cards, wire transfers, crypto, or payment apps.

Protect yourself by never sharing personal or financial information through unsolicited emails, texts, or phone calls. Be cautious with links, QR codes, and attachments you did not expect. If something feels urgent or too good to be true, pause and verify through official channels before taking action.
